Buoys and Beacons IALA* Buoyage System

Where in force, the IALA System applies to all fixed and floating marks and occasionally lighthouses, sector lights, range marks, lightships and LANBY's (large automatic navigational buoys).

The standard buoy shapes are cylindrical (can), conical Δ , spherical Ω , pillar (including high focal plane) A, and spar A, but variations may occur, for example lightfloats A in the illustrations below, only the standard buoy shapes are used. In the case of fixed beacons (lighted or unlighted), only the shape of the topmark is of navigational significance.
